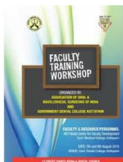

**AUDITORS REPORT**

1. I have audited the attached Balance Sheet of the Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons of India (Regn. No. Maharashtra/154/2001/Pune) as at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015 and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date prepared in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Society management. My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit.
2. I conducted my audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. Those standards require that I plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement. An audit includes examining on a text basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. My audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. I believe that my audit provides a reasonable basis for my opinion.
3. I have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of my knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of my audit, except that for some expenses no vouchers have been received.
4. In my opinion, Institution has kept proper books of accounts so far as it appears from my examination of those books.
5. Balance with banks is subject to confirmation/reconciliation.
6. The Balance Sheet and the Income and Expenditure Account dealt by this report are in agreement with books of account.



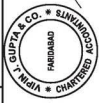
